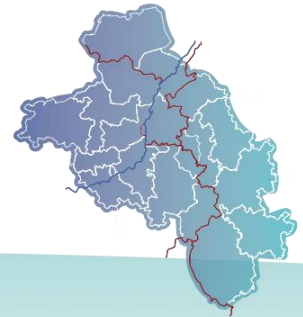

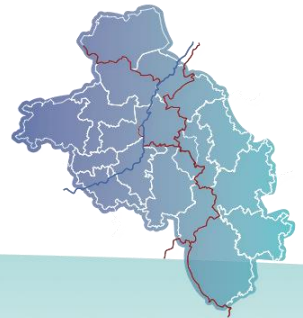

- Content/focus

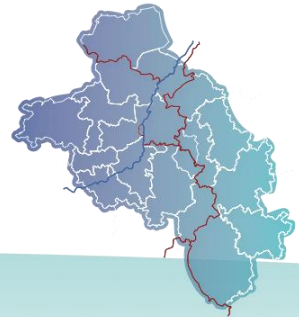
